 - (a) REGULAR Anyone who was a member of the Guard becomes a Regular Member upon payment of the prescribed dues.
 - (b) AFFILIATE Anyone who was employed at Fort Henry in any other capacity or anyone so accepted by the Board of Directors becomes an Affiliate Member upon payment of the
 - prescribed dues.
